Beste Lezer,

Misschien heeft u het ook gezien (zie link bovenaan): op EenVandaag (NPO1) werd dinsdagavond 14 nov. 2017 een filmpje over de moorden op boeren* in Zuid-Afrika, uitgezonden.

Een belangrijke aanleiding tot de moorden is haatspraak (door politieke leider Julius Malema – zie foto – van de partij Economic Freedom Fighters) die door de regerende ANC gedoogd wordt en soms zelfs (zij het in iets afgezwakte vorm) door president Zuma nagepraat wordt (*Daily Dispatch 18-02-2015, www.dispatchlive.co.za*). Alleen in 2017 (t/m oktober) zijn er al meer dan 340 overvallen op boeren geweest waarbij er meer dan 70 boerenmensen vermoord werden. (*Afriforum, bericht Maroela Media 25-10-2017.*) Dit is een verschijnsel dat al vele jaren lang zo doorgaat. Voorbeelden van uitspraken van Malema ziet u ruim 16 regels naar beneden.

* De getroffen boeren zijn vooral de grondeigenaren en/of -huurders van grote relatief afgelegen boerenbedrijven, in tegenstelling tot de bestaansboeren die op staats- of communale grond leven. Deze grondeigenaren en -huurders zijn in meerderheid blank en daarom ligt het politiek gevoelig (ook in Nederland) om daar wat van te zeggen.

Maar de zwarte minderheid onder de kopersliële boeren heeft óók onder de moorden te lijden: een voorbeeld is dhr. Patrick Itumeleng (68 jaar) (foto), een welvarende Tswanasprekende zwarte ondernemer die 7 jaar geleden een boerenbedrijf in de buurt van het dorp Vrijburg (provincie Noordwest) kocht en daar kippen, schapen en runderen hield. Hij werd op vrijdagavond 30 juni 2017 door 5 rovers overvallen en overleed aan 4 schotwonden. Zijn vrouw Dinah kreeg één schotwond en overleefde. Zijn 3 volwassen kinderen waren er gelukkig niet bij. De vijf rovers gingen er met contant geld en een ongeopende kluis vandoor. (*Beeld, 4 juli 2017.*)

Bij blanke boeren gaat het om soortgelijke verhalen, maar in voorkomende gevallen dan ook nog met marteling (denk aan kokend water of een strijkbout) en/of verkrachting erbovenop. Haatspraak heeft helaas wél effect!

Enkele voorbeelden van uitspraken van Julius Malema:

1. "Little did they (*the whites*) know that we are not scared of blood. We are scared of defeat. We don't want to be defeated but seeing blood is not what we are scared of. As long as that blood delivers what belongs to us we are prepared to go to that extent." (*Harare, 13-10-2012: Malema's address to Zanu-PF youth as reported by the Zimbabwe Herald 16-10-2012.*)

2. He said the youths in South Africa were calling for whites to surrender land and minerals resources they hold because "when they came from Europe they did not carry any land into South Africa".

"What we are asking is for them to surrender our minerals because they did not come with any mineral. We want that land and those minerals for free because they never paid for those minerals." (*Harare, 13-10-2012: Malema's address to Zanu-PF youth as reported by the Zimbabwe Herald 16-10-2012.*)

3. "We are not calling for the slaughter of white people, at least for now... The rightful owners of the land are black people. No white person is a rightful owner of the land here in South Africa and whole of the African continent," (Newcastle, South Africa - November 7, 2016: Malema addressing a crowd outside Newcastle Magistrate's Court after his appearance there, reported by Business Day, South Africa, 7-11-2016)

Voorbeelden van geweldsmisdaden tegen blanke boerengezinnen

Onlangs voorbeelden van overvallen op blanke slachtoffers ziet u hieronder, met als eerste voorbeeld de moord van 7 april 2017 op een in Zuid-Afrika wonende Nederlander, Peet van Es. Deze moord komt ook in de TV-uitzending EenVandaag aan bod. Het tweede voorbeeld is nog recenter: zondagavond 19 november 2017. Het derde voorbeeld is uit 2014 en laat zien dat er overvallers zijn die extreme methoden niet schuwen om hun zin af te dwingen. Het vierde voorbeeld, weer uit 2017, is één waarbij een geziene plattelandse arts (tevens boer) en zijn vrouw (eveneens arts) met zeer slechte afloop werden overvallen. Ten slotte komt de minister van politie aan het woord met de zoveelste constatering vanuit de overheid, dat er wat aan het probleem moet worden gedaan.

Farm attack: Man begged for life

"Before they killed him, I could hear him screaming so hard, asking them not to kill him. But they did"

BARBERTON – Peet van Es (55) begged his attackers to spare his life before he was brutally murdered during a farm attack in his home on Friday night, April 7.

His wife, Ms Arine Prins, recounted the night of horror to Lowvelder on Saturday. "Don't kill me, you can take anything you want" she recalls hearing.

He was nonetheless stabbed to death, while Prins and a friend, Mr Michael Watt, were assaulted by five armed men. She said the attackers wore balaclavas. They entered the house at Moseley Farm on the R40 outside Barberton shortly after 20:00.

Van Es and Prins were originally from the Netherlands, but moved to South Africa many years ago. Prins was badly bruised. She told the newspaper that three armed men entered the house and two followed them later. "My husband was sleeping upstairs and we were downstairs when they arrived. They told us to be quiet and immediately took my phone. They tied our hands and legs using speaker wires.

"They assaulted me, demanding to know where we kept the safe. They covered my head with a plastic bag and used a pillow trying to suffocate me. They put me on the water bed and tried to rape me, but couldn't."

During her ordeal, some of the men went upstairs and stabbed her husband in the back. She wasn't sure how many. "Before they killed him, I could hear him screaming so hard, asking them not to kill him. But they did," she said. "He told them to take anything they wanted, but that didn't stop them."

"They took the jewellery I was wearing and other things in the house before leaving. After they left, I screamed for help. Fortunately the neighbours heard me," said Prins.

The suspects left after 00:00. Hi-Tech Barberton arrived at the scene first. Mr Sakkie Dednam of Hi-Tech said they received the call-out at 00:36 and responded immediately. Officers arrived at 00:50. "Upon their arrival, the deceased was already dead," he said.

According to police spokesman, Brig Leonard Hlathi, they are investigating the murder and house robbery. Nobody has been arrested. He confirmed that Van Es was stabbed with an unknown object when a struggle ensued between him and the suspects.

They stole various electrical appliances, including televisions and the victim's vehicle. The vehicle was later discovered abandoned in Brander Street, Mbombela by Hi-Tech Nelspruit, said according to business employees in the area it was likely abandoned there since the weekend. "A community member who read the article spotted it and informed us. Some of the people said they first saw it on Monday morning," Police were also called to the scene.



Provincial police commissioner, Lt Gen Mondli Zuma, condemned the attack. "To anyone that is involved in this kind of evil, you can run but you cannot hide. It is only a matter of time before we catch you, then send you to where people like you belong," said Zuma.



Manhunt for farm attack suspects

HOEDSPRUIT (Limpopo) – A farmer was killed last night during a farm attack. Police spokesman, Lt Col Moatshe Ngoepe said the police had launched a manhunt for three suspects involved in the attack which occurred last night at about 20:30 on a farm outside the town.

He said Christo Redelinghuys (60) and his daughter Retha went outside to lock their gate. “When they went back to the house, they noticed three armed men standing next to the house.”

When Redelinghuys asked what they wanted, without answering him, they shot him dead. “The daughter was left unharmed.”

The police were summoned and reacted swiftly to the scene. A manhunt and investigations ensued.

“At this stage **the motive is not clear, because there was no indication of any items stolen from the house** but the ongoing police investigations will tell.”

Plaasaanval Ermelo: Bejaardes met kookwater, strykyster gemartel

Boerderij-overval dichtbij Ermelo (provincie Mpumalanga): Bejaarden met kokend water en strijkijzer gemarteld. (Bericht vrij uit het Afrikaans vertaald en ingekort.)

Een bejaard echtpaar werd vroeg donderdagochtend 3 april 2014 dichtbij Ermelo, Mpumalanga overvallen en met kokend water en een strijkijzer gemarteld. Sergeant Gerald Sedibe, politiewoordvoerder, bevestigde aan Maroela Media dat het echtpaar donderdagochtend heel vroeg in de slaapkamer van hun woning op de farm Blaauwkop*, door drie gewapende mannen overvallen werd. De echtelieden Edward en Ina de Villiers zijn 76 resp. 73 jaar oud; hun namen werden inmiddels op sociale media bekendgemaakt. *(Spelling volgens krant Hoëvelder.)

“De overvallers hebben ze vastgebonden en kokend water over ze uitgegoten,” zei Sgt Sedibe. “Ze hebben geld en de sleutels van de kluis geëist.” Het is niet bekend waarom de slachtoffers de sleutels niet overhandigden.

“Daarna hebben de mannen de vrouw met een heet strijkijzer op haar borst gebrand in een poging om alsnog aan de sleutels te komen,” vervolgde Sgt Sedibe. Uiteindelijk braken de overvallers de kluis uit de muur en vluchtten in de pickup truck van het echtpaar. (*Uit een later bericht van de plaatselijke krant Hoëvelder blijkt dat de overval 90 minuten duurde, van 02.30 uur tot 04.00 uur.*)

De boer kon zich bevrijden en hulp via de noordradio ontbieden. Een buurman liet een ziekenauto komen. De daders zijn ontsnapt maar de pickup truck en de kluis werden dezelfde dag teruggevonden. De echtelieden werden in de kliniek te Ermelo behandeld. (*Volgens de krant Hoëvelder werden ze dezelfde ochtend vervolgens naar een ziekenhuis in Johannesburg overgebracht.*) De man, met brandwonden aan hoofd en gezicht, verkeert in stabiele toestand. Zijn vrouw verkeert in ernstige toestand. (*Uit berichten in kranten Beeld en Hoëvelder kan men opmaken dat de vrouw op beide borsten werd gebrand, maar dat man en vrouw beiden een week later buiten levensgevaar in stabiele toestand in het ziekenhuis verkeerden. De daders waren nog niet gepakt.*)

Doctor killed, family injured in Limpopo farm attack

On the same day that Police Minister Fikile Mbalula said farm attacks had to stop, a Lephala doctor was shot dead on his farm.

Dr Werner Emslie and his family were attacked on Wednesday night 20-09-2017 at about 19:00 on the farm Goedehoop in the Afguns area (near Lephala/Ellisras in Limpopo province) by at least four men, two of them armed, **Netwerk** reported.

Police spokesperson Brigadier John Masia said the attackers shot and killed Emslie and wounded his wife Mariëtte and daughter Barbara.

Mariëtte, who is also a medical doctor, was severely assaulted as well, and was rushed in a critical condition to a Pretoria hospital for treatment.

According to an acquaintance of the family, Barbara was also seriously wounded, but not as critically as her mother.*

From a report by the Sunday paper Rapport on October 15, 2017 it was clear that Dr Mariëtte Emslie was then still in hospital, in the rehabilitation unit and was recovering, but was confined to a wheelchair because a bullet had passed through her spine. There was still no clear indication that she would ever be able to walk again. Her children, Grant (23) and Barbara (19), were both present during the Rapport interview.

The attackers fled in Mariëtte's car, which was later found abandoned near the farm. From there, they had fled on foot.

Masia said no arrests had been made and the motive for the attack would be determined during the police investigation.

Mbalula said after meeting on Wednesday with rights organisation AfriForum that everything possible had to be done to ensure safety in rural areas.

Pretoria – The majority of farmers in South Africa are not racist and should continue to do their work without fear, Police Minister Fikile Mbalula said on Wednesday.

Mbalula was addressing the media at the South African Police Service (SAPS) head office in Pretoria, following a meeting with AgriSA to discuss the national rural safety programme.
